(completed Application with required documents is due ELECTRONICALLY no later than 5:00 p.m. on February 26st)

Advisors & Candidates

Please review the State Officer Handbook, Application and Agreement thoroughly.

Expectations for State FFA Officers are high and it is of utmost importance that Candidates understand fully these expectations.

The State FFA Officer Application is <u>electronic</u>, and the following items must be uploaded at the end of the application. Each of these should be labeled with the applicant's name and what the item is. (John Doe-Signature Page, etc)

- 1. Signature Page (must be printed, physically signed, scanned and uploaded)
- 2. State Degree Application
- 3. Photo of the Applicant
- 4. Biography of Applicant
 - a. guidelines must be followed Ariel-11 font, up to 400 words total
 - b. example below in this document
- 5. Letter of Application (example below in this document)

The Advisor's Recommendation is a separate electronic form to maintain its confidentiality. (DUE FEBRUARY 26 by 5:00 p.m.)

If a 2nd Advisor's Recommendation is needed for a candidate who is selected to advance to State Interviews. It is also to be completed electronically to maintain confidentiality. (DUE by 5:00 p.m. within 5 (five) days after the Area Interview)

Each Area FFA Association determines the time, date, location and any additional requirements for the interviews to select their candidates to attend the state selection.

- 1 Check with your local FFA Advisor, the Area MVATA President or the Area FFA Advisor regarding additional information and the process used to select candidates at the area level. (i.e. The State Officer interview process is slightly different in each area.)
- 2 Advisor Recommendation due February 26 via the electronic form titled: <u>Advisor</u> <u>Recommendation for State Officer Candidate.</u>
- 3 State FFA Officer Application will ask for the following information. Have the following information available when you start your application. It can be saved so you can complete it later the following items on or before <u>February 26</u>.
 - a. Personal contact (applicant, advisor & parents)
 - b. New Officer Activity Dates
 - c. Jacket and Shirt Order Form
 - d. Future Plans

Letter of Application

A letter of application is usually your first introduction when applying for a position with an organization. The letter of application should give the reader a reason to look at your resume and/or application. There are several common components to include in your letter of application. They are listed below. A successful letter of application will articulately and passionately address why you desire to serve as a state officer in <u>500 words or less and</u> <u>should be single spaced.</u>

Some components to consider in your letter of application:

- 1) Date of letter
- 2) Address letter to State Officer Nominating Committee Members; 205 Jefferson St. Jefferson City, MO 65102
- 3) Introductory paragraph
- 4) Paragraph about your background or experience which you believe qualifies you for the responsibility of the state office.
- 5) One to two paragraphs addressing why you desire to serve as a state officer.
- 6) A concluding paragraph moving the reader to consider you.
- 7) Appropriate closing and typed name (as signature).

Important information if you are selected as a finalistfor State FFA Officer

IT IS IMPORTANT YOU UNDERSTAND THIS INFORMATION!

1. Thoroughly read the officer agreement and understand the commitment you have made to the Missouri FFA.

2. Secure a 2nd recommendation from a FFA Advisor at a different school than your own. This recommendation should be completed by the other advisor electronically and submitted. You have 5 business days to for this task to be <u>completed</u>. The form can be found on the ______

_3. You will have another interview prior to State FFA Convention. This interview will occur on Friday, April 11 and Saturday, April 12, 2025. You and your advisor will be notified <u>via email</u> of the final agenda including location and times.

____4. The preliminary round portion will occur on **Friday, April 11, 2025**, which includes a personal interview, written test, writing exercise, and a stand & deliver activity. Starting times will be staggered so all candidates will not have to wait all day. These times will be included in the agenda sent to you.

5. In the **evening (Friday, April 11, 2025)** following the preliminary round there be a dinner and program <u>for all candidates</u> that interview. Information will be in theemail sent to you.

6. Hotel rooms will be available for you the evening of April 11th. <u>Please notify the</u> <u>executive secretary by **Friday**, **March 21**</u> if you the candidate will be utilizing the hotel room. This expense is part of the fee that your chapter will pay. Advisors and/ or parents will be responsible for their own lodging if needed.

_____7. On **Saturday morning, April 12th**, during a breakfast reception those advancing will be announced. Those selected (approx. 20-22) will need to be in attendance for remainder of the day for interviews which will include a group and/or facilitation activity, another personal round, and possibly a third activity if warranted by the nominating committee. Those not selected will be free to leave following the announcement.

8. During the **afternoon of Saturday, April 12**th (TBD), the nominating committee will announce the final sixteen selected to be Missouri State FFA Officers. President, 1st Vice President, and Secretary <u>WILL NOT</u> be announced until the business session at State FFA Convention on Thursday, April 24, 2025.
