

2021 State CDE Updates for 4-5-21

General Reminders:

**All students/Advisors are required to wear a face covering.
Gaiter masks are not allowed.**

Please remind students to bring water bottles as fountains are not accessible, but there are water filling stations at most sites.

Horses:

The address to the horse facility is at 1350 S. Roby Farm Rd, Rocheport. It takes about 25-30 minutes to get there from campus and is about 15 minutes from the Rocheport/I-70 exit.

The turn around at the location will work for a bus, but will be tight. If possible, bringing a school van for drop-off would be ideal, but busses will work.

Please have your students bring a bag or lawn chair to sit for the test and during preparation for reasons, as there is no seating on site.

Ag Mech:

Please refer to the tool list on page 6, #11. Participants should use auto darkening helmets in order to not have masks under helmets while welding. Students will NOT need oxy goggles or a chipping hammer.

Students will have ample access to sanitation wipes and hand sanitizer will be used between every station.

Dairy Foods:

Dairy Foods participants will have milk samples, real/artificial, milk fat, and cheese samples poured for them or pre-portioned for them. Students will be provided a solo cup to spit into after samples. The timing for the event will be at 40 minutes per rotation instead of 36 minutes.

Soils: Location of soils will be shared the Friday before the contest.
