



MISSOURI ASSOCIATION OF FAIRS & FESTIVALS PAST PRESIDENTS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Missouri Association of Fairs & Festivals (MAFF) Past Presidents Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce 2024-2025 applications are available for the \$1,000 scholarship.

MAFF Requirements:

- a. Applications **MUST** be completed from the fillable PDF file, saved as applicant last-first name-county, i.e. Schlueter-Elizabeth-Lincoln. **Hand-written applications will not be accepted.**
- b. The application follows. Please note the application deadline and the address to which the application and essay should be emailed.
- c. **Recipient must be present at the MAFF Convention on Saturday, February 8, 2025, to receive scholarship award.** Convention held at Margaritaville Lake Resort, Osage Beach, Missouri.
- d. Documents must be submitted as ONE PDF document in the following order: three-page application/signature sheet, two-page essay, resume (one page preferred, maximum of two pages); school transcript, signed by school official.

Additional Requirements:

- 1) Applicant must actively participate as a MAFF member fair to be eligible for this scholarship.
- 2) Only students graduating High School in the spring of 2025 are eligible.
- 3) **Student must have a 2.5 grade point (based on 4.0 systems) and maintain a 2.5 grade point during their first semester of college, while carrying at least 12 credit hours.**
- 4) Scholarship funds are available at the beginning of **the second semester following confirmation of 2.5 grade point average during first semester.** Student awarded scholarship must submit verification of enrollment form along with proof of grade point at conclusion of first semester to enable payment of scholarship funds. Payment of the scholarship is made directly to the college the recipient attends.
- 5) Award must be claimed within 15 months of presentation.
- 6) Applicant must submit a resume, one-page preferred, maximum of two pages, with application.
- 7) A two-page essay composed by the applicant must be submitted with the application. The essay should emphasize applicant's personal growth and development, leadership and community service experiences including 4-H, FFA and/or other service organizations. Applicant should explain how receiving this scholarship would allow recipient to improve the county fair in the future. Successful applicant must demonstrate their support of school, community, and the fair/festival environment.
- 8) **School Transcript showing class rank, total credits, and test scores from SAT or ACT must be emailed with completed application by the application deadline.**
- 9) Scholarship applications will be available through MAFF website www.mofairs.org, MAFF member fair, 4-H Youth Specialists, school and/or Vocational Agriculture instructors.
- 10) MAFF Member fair may submit multiple applications.
- 11) For purposes of this scholarship, the Missouri State Fair is not an eligible member-fair due to the difference in involvement with participants. However, Missouri State Fair experience may be included as part of the essay.
- 12) M.A.F.F. reserve the rights to modify these rules as necessary.
