

OFFICIAL RULES – Missouri Golden Owl Award® Contest

These are the Official Rules of the Missouri Golden Owl Award® Contest (“Contest”). The Contest is co-sponsored by the Missouri FFA Foundation, 3610 Buttonwood Drive, Columbia, MO 65201; FSC Financial, 1934 E. Miller Street, Jefferson City, MO 65101; and Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company (“Sponsors”), One Nationwide Plaza, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must be Missouri-licensed educators currently teaching agricultural education courses at the secondary (middle/high school), adult (community) or post-secondary level. **No purchase is necessary.**

Nominations can be submitted by the general public, current or former students, parents, fellow educators, school administrators and community members.

TEACHERS MAY NOT SELF-NOMINATE.

Employees, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies, and any entity involved in the development, production, implementation, administration or fulfillment of the Contest (all of the foregoing, together with Nationwide, MOFFA Foundation, and FCS Financial collectively referred to as "Promotion Entities") and their immediate family members and/or those living in the same household of such persons, whether related or not, are not eligible to enter the Contest.

HOW TO ENTER

The Nomination period begins September 22, 2025 and ends December 31, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. CST (“Nomination Period”).

To enter, provide your and the ag teacher’s contact information, including an essay (250 words or less) describing how the teacher’s dedication to agriculture education, and commitment and impact on today’s youth make the teacher the best in the state.

Entry constitutes consent to participate in the Contest and for the MO FFA Foundation to obtain, use, and transfer the entrant’s name, address and other details for Contest administration purposes. MO FFA Foundation will not be responsible for lost, incomplete, illegible, late, misdirected, stolen, or mutilated entries; technical or mechanical malfunctions; errors in the Official Rules, in any related ads or materials; or processing errors. MO FFA Foundation can void the entry of any Entrant who it believes has attempted to tamper with or impair Contest administration, security, fairness, or proper play.

HONOREE DETERMINATION

An established committee will evaluate nominations received and select sixteen (16) area semi-finalists as defined by MOFFA’s area, and two (2) additional semi-finalists representing post-secondary/adult education across the state.

Nominations will be judged based on the following criteria:

1. Teacher’s dedication to agriculture education
2. Teacher’s commitment to his/her student(s)
3. Teacher’s impact on his/her student(s)
4. Teacher’s impact on their local community
5. Teacher’s impact on the agriculture industry
6. Number of nominations for the teacher

The eighteen (18) semi-finalists will be announced during FFA Week. A representative from FCS Financial will present each semi-finalist with a \$250 check. Semi-finalists will be required to complete a form for consideration as one of the seven (7) Honorees.

An established committee will review these forms and select (1) one Honoree from each of MOFFA’s 6 districts plus one (1) Honoree who is a post-secondary/adult educator from anywhere in Missouri. These seven (7) Honorees will be announced by April 8, 2026 via surprise visits to their schools from a representative from the Missouri FFA Foundation, FCS Financial and Nationwide Insurance. Finalists will be given a \$500 check at these visits and invited to attend the 2025 MOFFA State Convention. At the Convention, the grand prize winner will be announced.

In the event of a tie, the teacher receiving the highest number of nominations shall be selected as Honoree, as determined by the selection committee.

GRAND PRIZE WINNER DETERMINATION

Each of the semi-finalists will be required to complete a short form to be considered as one of the seven (7) Honorees, one of whom will be chosen as the overall State winner. This completed form will be due by February 24, 2026.

Ahead of the 2026 Missouri FFA State Convention, the committee will review forms submitted and select the seven (7) Honorees who will be recognized at the 2026 Missouri FFA State Convention. Honorees will be notified by April 8.

During that review process, the committee will also make their final selection for the Missouri Agricultural Educator of the Year. That individual’s name will not be released until the 2026 Missouri FFA State Convention. There the new Missouri Agricultural Educator of the Year will be announced.

If a Prize winner is not eligible to win, or if MO FFA is unable to contact the winner after a reasonable effort, the prize will be forfeited, and an alternate winner may be selected. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

SPONSORS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR TRAVEL-RELATED EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH PRIZE ACCEPTANCE.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

1. One (1) Grand Prize Winner: Trophy and \$3,000 cash prize to winner
2. Seven (7) Honorees: Plaque, framed certificate and \$500 cash prize to each honoree.
3. Eighteen (18) semi-finalists: Electronic certificate and \$250 cash prize to each semi-finalist.

Prizes are non-transferable, and no substitution will be made except as provided herein at the Sponsors' sole discretion. Sponsors reserve the right to substitute a prize for one of equal or greater value if the designated prize should become unavailable for any reason. Winners are responsible for all taxes and fees associated with prize receipt and/or use.

If requested, winners must execute and return an Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability Release and (where legal) Publicity Release within three days of notification. Failure to do so may result in disqualification, forfeiture, or award to alternate winner.

GENERAL RULES

The Contest is governed by and subject to the laws of the United States and the state of Ohio.

All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. Void where prohibited by law. Prize Winners may receive an IRS 1099 form for the value of their prizes. By participating in the Contest and/or accepting any prize, Entrants grant the Promotion Entities permission to use their name, likenesses, and image in connection with the Contest for purposes of advertising, publicity and promotion purposes, without further compensation to the entrant, unless prohibited by law. Entrants agree to be bound by the Official Rules and the decisions of the judges, which are final and binding on all matters relating to the Contest. The Promotion Entities are not responsible for any typographical or other errors in the printing of the offer, administration of the Contest or the announcement of the prizes, or for lost, late, misdirected, damaged, incomplete or illegal entries.

The Promotion Entities reserve the right at their sole discretion to disqualify any Entrant found to be (a) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or (b) violating the Official Rules.
